Ognidove design Luta Bettonica, Giancarlo Leone 2020

Wireless atmospheric lighting with a touch dimmer, intended for indoor or outdoor use, for relaxing, reading or as a centrepiece. The luminaire is available as a tabletop or a standard lamp version, with the possibility to add a vase for a single bloom. The lamp can also be customised by combining the elements with gold, silver or matt black finishes to suit your taste, each of which can be bought separately. The base is made of iron, the lamp and the vase of aluminium and the diffuser of transparent methacrylate whose surface has been subjected to a fine opaque treatment. In the tabletop version, the two elements of the lighting body and the vase are fitted with magnets to enable you to position them freely on the base or directly on any metal table. The composition's versatility is designed to suit any convivial occasion. When completed, for example, with a flower it is ideal for a dinner with friends, while twigs or dried flowers make it into a tasteful element of décor and with a Christmas star it is the ideal centrepiece in the Christmas dinners. Ognidove is wireless and can be put wherever you like (as the name implies in Italian: Everywhere), both indoors and outdoors.

The lamp Ognidove wins the Archiproducts Design Awards 2020 in the Lighting category. The judging panel of this fifth edition of the contest, including some among the most influential professionals of the Architecture and Design industry, awarded the title of Winner 2020 to Ognidove for its unique concept and design.
